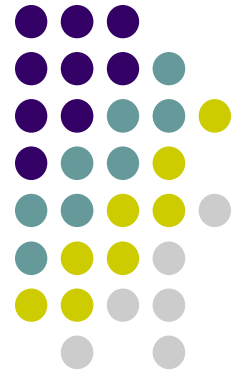


Title I Networking Session
