This season Debby will help you attract your "geek" readers with techy titles and techniques, and suggest books for your reluctant or struggling readers. She'll discuss gender-focused titles to entice and retain boy readers, keep girls' reader chat lines humming, and present books with the diverse range of LGBT teens. By bundling books thematically and structurally, and creating literature pairs, she'll help you put more of the right books in the hands of your students. Join Debby for an enthusiastic day of discovering books and strategies for differentiating instruction, stretching your student's critical thinking skills, and enhancing your library or classroom collection.

Each participant will receive a resource handbook, "*What's New in Young Adult Literature and How to Use It in Your Program – 2012*," filled with annotated bibliographies and ideas for using the new books in your classroom or library. Please note that the books Debby discusses during her presentation will be on hand for review and many will also be available for purchase.

About the presenter: Debby is a nationally known educator and presenter on young adult literature. Her experiences include teaching middle school and high school, offering graduate and undergraduate courses for present and future teachers, presenting at conferences, and working with education service centers, individual schools, and school districts.
